### Program Details

This 12-month program offers preparation to apply for and receive a Child Development Associate Certificate (CDA) specializing in infant-toddler care and development.

- Early childhood education classes are held two Saturdays a month. October 2019 - August 2020.
- Extra academic support, credential exam preparation, and job search assistance are all provided.
- **No cost to the student. Tuition is paid by a state grant.**
- Students must have high school diploma or recognized equivalent.
- Students must obtain 480 hours of work experience in a child care center with children ages 0 to 36 months.
- Participants gain the necessary knowledge and skills to work as an infant-toddler educator/ caregiver.
