Program Details

- This 12-month program offers extra academic support, credential exam preparation and job search assistance September 23, 2019 - September 30, 2020.
- Part-time training during the week: 6 hours of CDA training held 2 Saturdays per month; and 5 hours of VESL instruction held during the evening, two nights a week.
- **No cost to the student. Tuition is paid by a state grant.**
- Students must have high school diploma or recognized equivalent.
- Students must obtain 480 hours of experience in a child care center with children ages 0-3 years.
- Gain the necessary knowledge and skills to work as an infant-toddler educator/caregiver.
- Improve your English (Basic English reading, writing and speaking skills are required for this program – applicants must take an English proficiency test).
